## MODEL DISPLAY RULES TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR BEST OF SHOW VOTING

- 1. All entrants must be a member of one of the three <u>Societies and registered for the meet</u>. Any member may enter an unlimited number of entries in any scale. A separate contest entry form is required for each entry. **MODELS MUST BE THE WORK OF THE ENTRANT**.
- 2. If the builder is not present at the meet, the model(s) will be marked as Display Only and are not eligible to be voted on.
- 3. Models may be of any type, construction, either kit-built or scratch-built, or any combination thereof. Models may be commercially manufactured, including imported brass models, which have been kit bashed, detailed, painted, and/or decaled by the entrant. For commercially manufactured models, the entrant must describe the work performed.
- 4. Models will be placed on tables provided in the Contest Room. Additional data, information, or photos of the prototype may be placed in front of the model. The entry form contains space for data or information on the model. The entrant may bring the information pre-prepared on a card no larger than 8 ½" x 11" (standard paper size). Photos shall not be larger than an 8" x 10" print size.
- 5. Only Society members who are registered participants of the Meet are eligible to vote. Voting will be done by popular vote. Ballots will be furnished at the time designated by the Model Contest Chairman.
- 6. Models will be assigned numbers at the time of entry and will be displayed in the Contest Room for the membership to view and vote upon by ballot. Models receiving the most Best of Show votes will receive the Best of Show Award. First, Second, and Third runners-up will receive ribbons recognizing their achievement.
- 7. A separate display area will be provided for members or guests wishing to display models, but not wishing to enter the Model Contest.
- 8. All models must be claimed by the registered owners at the time designated by the Model Contest Chair. The Societies can assume no responsibility for unclaimed models.
- 9. The Societies reserve the right to photograph the winning models and to publish such photographs in future issues of their publications.
- 10. The Societies and their Contest Officials will not be responsible for loss or damage to any model entered in the Contest.
